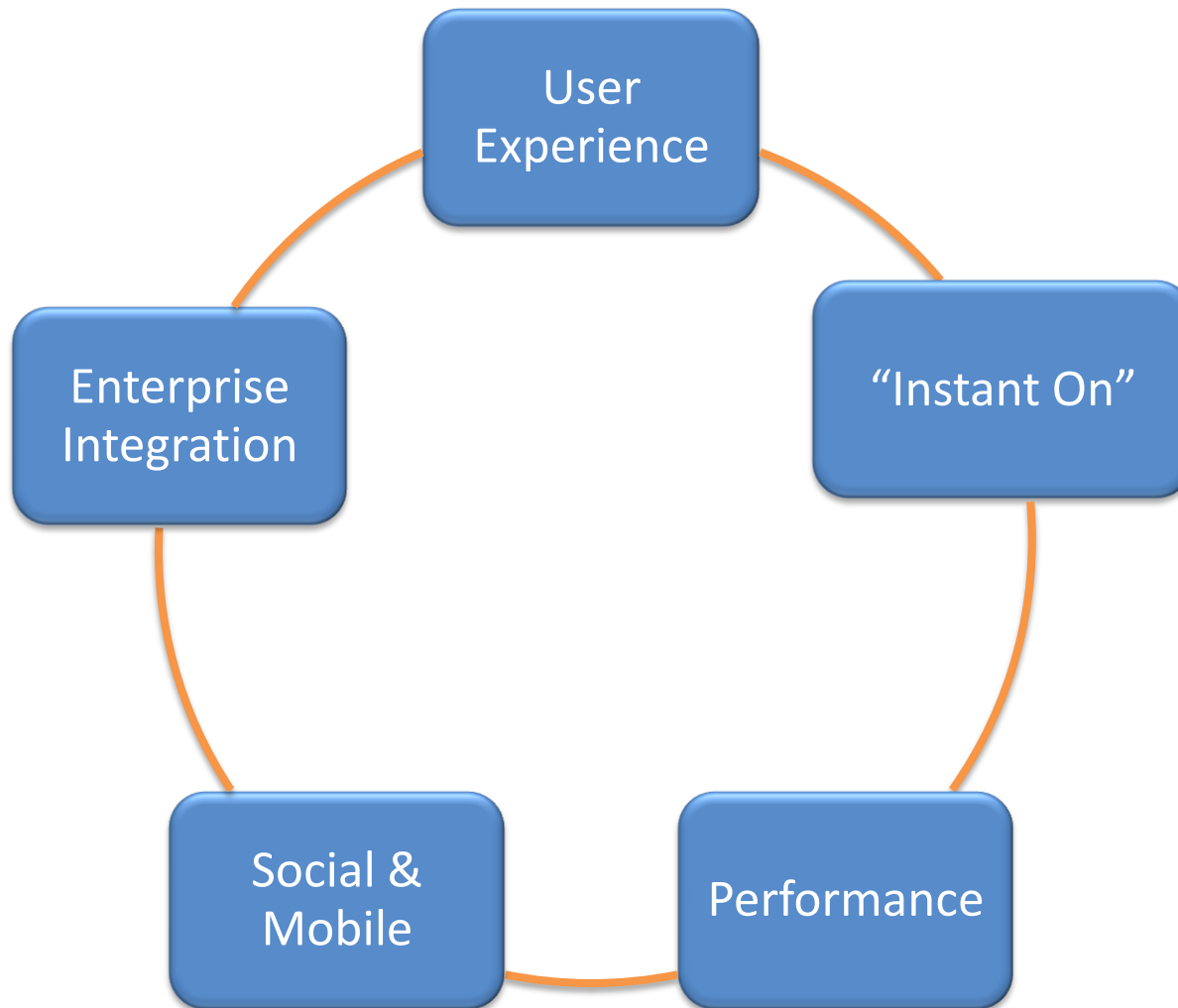

Other Stuff

- Razor Support coming via a new core module
 - Charles Nurse is implementing module
- Patching Support being strongly considered
 - Update specific DLLs to implement Security fix
 - No need to update entire Site.
 - Will require minimum site level.
- Cloud Support
 - Recent updates in Cloud offerings by Microsoft will help
 - DotNetNuke Staff reviewing
 - announced at PDC the week before Connections
 - Strong pressure for improvements on this issue

Other Stuff – cont'd



- Day of DNN coming for Spring
 - In the Washington DC area – proposed, not confirmed
 - Should be announced very soon
 - “HUGH news coming soon... stay tuned”
